Community Health Work/Promotor de Salud

A community health worker (CWH) is a trusted member of and/or has an unusually close understanding of the community served. This trusting relationship enables the CHW to serve as a liaison/link/intermediary between health/social services and the community to facilitate access to services and improve service delivery quality and cultural competence. A CHW also builds individual and community capacity by increasing health knowledge and self-sufficiency through a range of activities such as outreach, community education, informal counseling, social support, and advocacy.

Duties/Responsibilities:

Under the leadership of the COVID19 Project Leader and/or the assigned Department Manager, the COVID19 Community Health Worker/Promotor de Salud provides outreach, education, and support to community members. Outreach and education efforts focus on COVID19, testing, vaccination, and other topics that may help community members recover from the impact of COVID19. CHW's also help advocate for issues and inform service/policy improvements.

Requirements:

- Be part of and be well connected within the community
- Be knowledgeable of issues affecting historically marginalized populations
- Able to be deployed to provide services in one or more of the following North Carolina counties: Lee, Harnett, Montgomery, Moore, and Richmond
- Have a working knowledge of the use of computers, iPad, Microsoft, google suites, etc.
- Be willing to be trained in using the NC Department of Health and Human Services' Coronavirus Vaccine Management System (CVMS), NCCARE360 platform, and other similar platforms.
- Be creative, social, energetic, outgoing, flexible, self-motivated, detail-oriented, respectful, and able to speak with a diverse group of people with various literacy levels one-on-one or in large group settings.
- Have a car/driving license or reliable mode of transportation
- Have strong oral and written skills (knowledgeable of Spanish language a plus)
